

# TINY ROLLED HAT

**Size:** Approximately 8 inches around  
**Gauge:** 7 (6, 5) sts/inch  
**Yarn:** 25 grams sock/fingering weight (dk weight, worsted weight)  
**Needles:** U.S. size 3 (5, 7) double pointed needles  
**Notions:** Scissors  
Blunt darning needle  
Safety pin

Cast on 56, 48, 40 stitches onto double pointed needles. Join without twisting. Place a safety pin to mark the beginning of the round.

Round 1: Knit to the end of the round.

Repeat Round 1 until hat measures approximately 3 inches from the bottom of the ROLLED stockinette stitch brim.

Shaping [start with round 1 (3, 5) depending on how many stitches you started with]

Shaping Round 1: \*K5, K2tog; repeat from \* to the end of the round (48 stitches).  
Shaping Round 2: Knit to the end of the round.  
Shaping Round 3: \*K4, K2tog; repeat from \* to the end of the round (40 stitches).  
Shaping Round 4: Knit to the end of the round.  
Shaping Round 5: \*K3, K2tog; repeat from \* to the end of the round (32 stitches).  
Shaping Round 6: Knit to the end of the round.  
Shaping Round 7: \*K2, K2tog; repeat from \* to the end of the round (24 stitches).  
Shaping Round 8: Knit to the end of the round.  
Shaping Round 9: \*K1, K2tog; repeat from \* to the end of the round (16 stitches).  
Shaping Round 10: Knit to the end of the round.  
Shaping Round 11: \*K2tog; repeat from \* to the end of the round (8 stitches).

Finishing Option #1 (Plain top)

Cut yarn, leaving an 8 inch tail. Using a blunt darning needle, thread the tail through the remaining stitches, and pull tightly to close the hole.

Weave in ends.

Finishing Option #2 (I-cord knot)

Round 12: \*K2tog; repeat from \* to the end of the round (4 stitches).

Move remaining 4 stitches to one double pointed needle.

\* Knit 4

Transfer the right-hand needle over to your left hand without turning the needle around. Slide the four stitches to the other end of the needle, ready to be knit again. It will look like the yarn is coming from the wrong end of the needle.

Repeat from \* until the little knitted tube measures approximately 4 inches.

Cut yarn, leaving an 8 inch tail. Using a blunt darning needle, thread yarn tail through all four stitches and pull tightly. Weave into center of i-cord.

Tie i-cord into a loose overhand knot.
